Classroom teachers will communicate with the Encore staff if a student is in need of the Homework Club services and if a student attending after school has classroom work due.

REGISTRATION

Students may sign up for one or more of the activity groups. We will make every attempt to assign students to at least one activity they choose. Some activities are very popular. If your child has participated in an activity in the last three sessions that has high enrollment, they will most likely not be able to do the activity again, so other students have an opportunity to participate. Class sizes are limited so please don't sign up your child for an activity group if they have a sports practice or an outside of school activity on the day of the activity.

GROUPS

Most activities have a limit of 12. If there are less than 6 students for an activity it will not be held. Tutoring will always be held on scheduled days and students can join at any time during a session.

FEES

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\$3.50 per day for 3 children in the same family

If you are not able to pay the fee, please sign your child up regardless, all students will be placed in at least 1 group, more if room is available.

SNACKS

Students will receive a snack. We ask students not to bring their own snack, due to some students having food allergies.

HOMEWORK

We will start at 3:15 with homework and snack. If students have no homework other than reading, books and learning activities will be available.
