REGISTRATION

Students may sign up for one or more of the activity groups. We will make every attempt to assign students to at least one activity they choose. Some activities are very popular. If your child has participated in an activity in the last three sessions that has high enrollment, they will most likely not be able to do the activity again, so other students have an opportunity to participate. Class sizes are limited so please don't sign up your child for an activity group if they have a sports practice or an outside of school activity on the day of the activity.

GROUPS

Most activities have a limit of 12. If there are less than 6 students for an activity it will not be held. Homework Club will always be held on scheduled days and students can join at any time during a session.

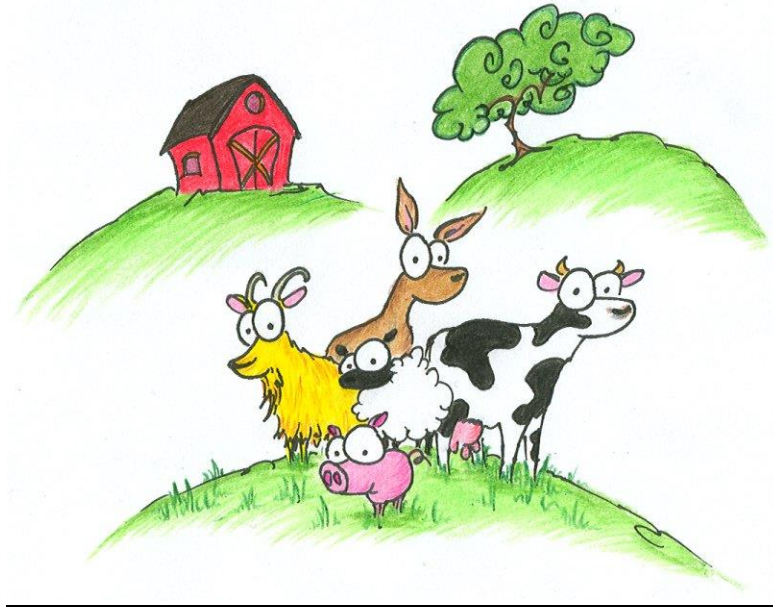
LEGO CHALLENGE

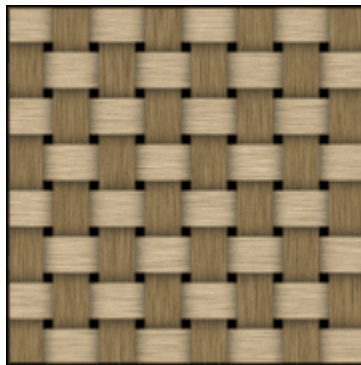
